

## LES GROTTES D'ARCIS SAINT-EMILION GRAND CRU



« Les grottes d'Arcis » is the name of a little plot in the heart of the vineyard of Saint-Emilion, belonging to Château Tour Baladoz. When the De Schepper family, owner since 1950 of Tour Baladoz, bought the plot in 1982, the wine "Les grottes d'Arcis" was born. The name is no coincidence, as the vineyard rests on quarries from the XVIII<sup>th</sup> Century. Surrounded by plots of First Growth Classified wines on an excellent terroir, the vines of Les Grottes d'Arcis produce wines of great quality since many years.
